Zman

Dusk is the amount of time it takes to walk half a *mil* after sunset. Dusk is a time of doubt if it is day or night.

Daytime is when there is sunlight in the horizon. There can still be stars in the sky but so long as there is sunlight it is then considered day. There is no uncertainty period by day.

Prayer

When saying the Amidah, ones' feet must be together and equal – toe to toe and heel to heel.

When responding to birchas kohanim by shachris respond: To the first bracha: בְּרַכּוּ אֶת יְיָ מְלֹאכֵינוּ, to the second bracha: בְּרַכּוּ אֶת יְיָ כָּל-צְבָאוֹי, and to the third bracha: בְּרַכּוּ אֶת יְיָ מְעֻשָׂיו.

When responding to birchas kohanim by mussaf respond: To the first bracha: שִׁיר הַמַּעֲלוֹת, to the second bracha: הִנֵּה בְּרַכּוּ אֶת יְיָ כָּל-עַבְדֵי יְיָ הָעוֹמְדִים בְּבַיִת יְיָ בְּלִילוֹת, and to the third bracha: יְבָרְכֶךָ יְיָ מִצִּיּוֹן.
