Teffilah

Kiryas Shema is said by night and by day. The night kriyas shema is said from the time the stars appear, even while there may be some light left to the day. It can be said all night but best to say it by midnight so one does not wait too long.

Korbonos

The same is true about offerings. If they must be eaten by the night, the time is until just before dawn.

Shabbos

If one did melacha on Friday afternoon when one star appeared he is not liable, it is day. When two stars appeared, he brings a asham. Three stars he brings a chattos.
